This is notice to all members that the Chapter Elections process is about to begin. It will culminate in April with Chapter Election Certifications and the conducting of annual chapter meeting to review and finalize the results of your chapter election.

Write-ins are not allowed in this election.

If necessary, ballots will be mailed to the last known home mailing address as of February 25, 2019 no later than March 1, 2019.

Ballots must be received at the SEA Office, 207 North Main Street, Concord, NH 03301 by 5 PM on March 29, 2019 or postmarked no later than March 29, 2019.

- President (Term Expires 2021):** The president shall be the executive head of this chapter with full power to enforce the provisions of the by-laws. He/she shall conduct all meetings of the chapter.
- Vice-President (Term Expires 2021):** -The vice president shall assist the president and in the absence or disability of the president, assume the duties of the president; shall be chairperson of this chapter's membership committee and submit a monthly report to the chapter secretary.
- Treasurer (Term Expires 2021):** The treasurer shall be the custodian of the funds of this chapter; and give a financial report at each regular meeting of this chapter, and submit to the annual meeting of this chapter an itemized financial statement for the fiscal year.
- Assistant Treasurer (Term Expires 2021):**
The Assistant Treasurer shall receive assignments from the Treasurer, or the President in the absence of the Treasurer and shall have the authority to prepare reports and disperse chapter funds as directed. The Assistant Treasurer shall be a member of the Executive Committee with voting privileges.
- Councilor (Term Expires 2021):**
It shall be the duty of councilors to keep the chapter membership informed at all times of union matters; to poll the members in order to determine their stand on issues; and to represent the chapter's members at annual conventions and quarterly council meetings.
- Alternate Councilor (Term Expires 2021):**
It shall be the duty of alternate councilors to stand in for councilors at annual conventions and quarterly council meetings when regular councilors are unable to attend.
